- Non-EU countries: Switzerland, UK, Iceland, Turkey, Israel, Morocco, Norway

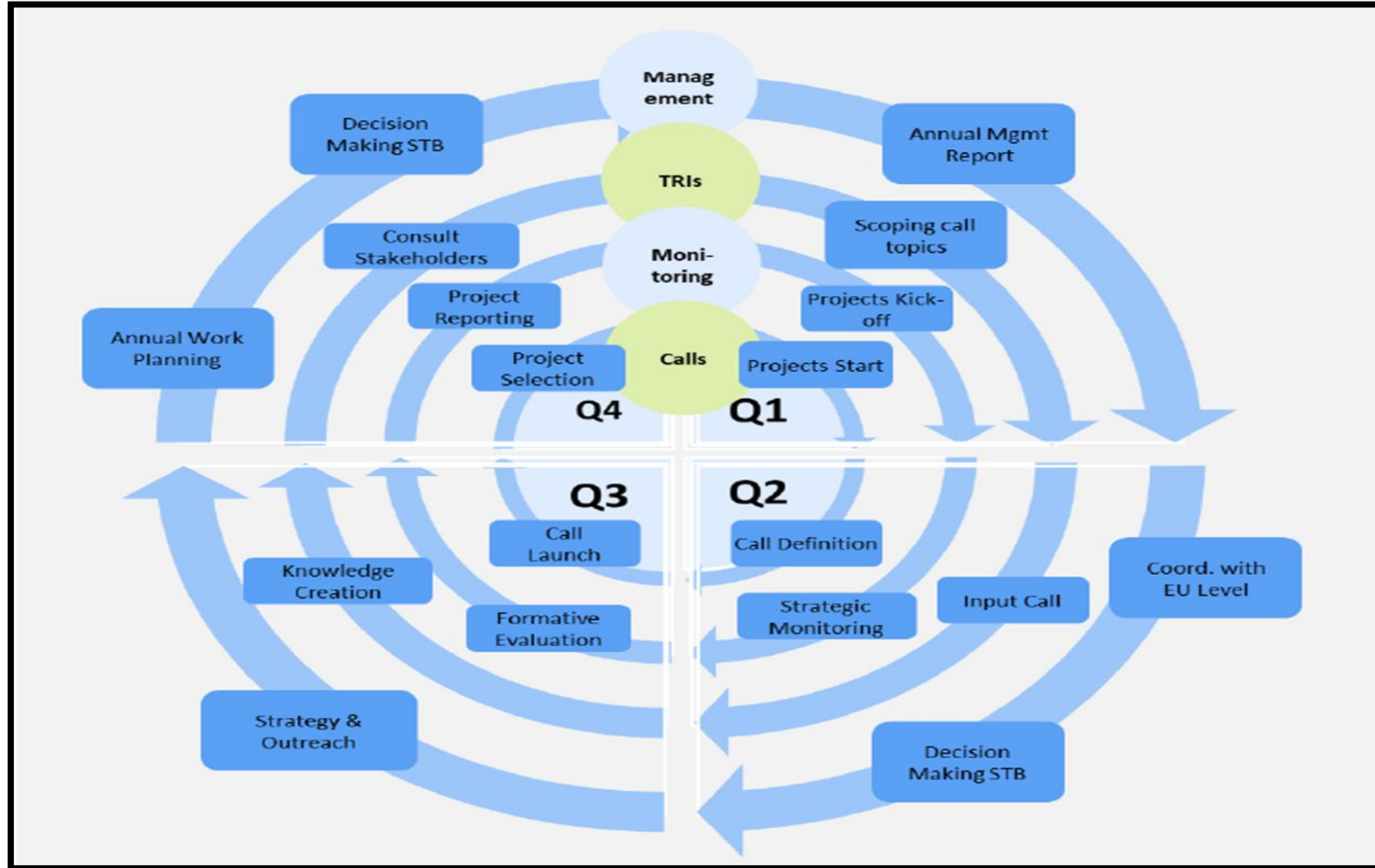
CETP Implementation

- Yearly calls 2022-27 (6 calls in total)
- Total budget for 6 calls €995 000 000

- JULICH GMBH - €37 142 857
- B.A.U.M. CONSULT GMBH - €5 540 726.25
- MKM - €1 500 000

CETP Rules

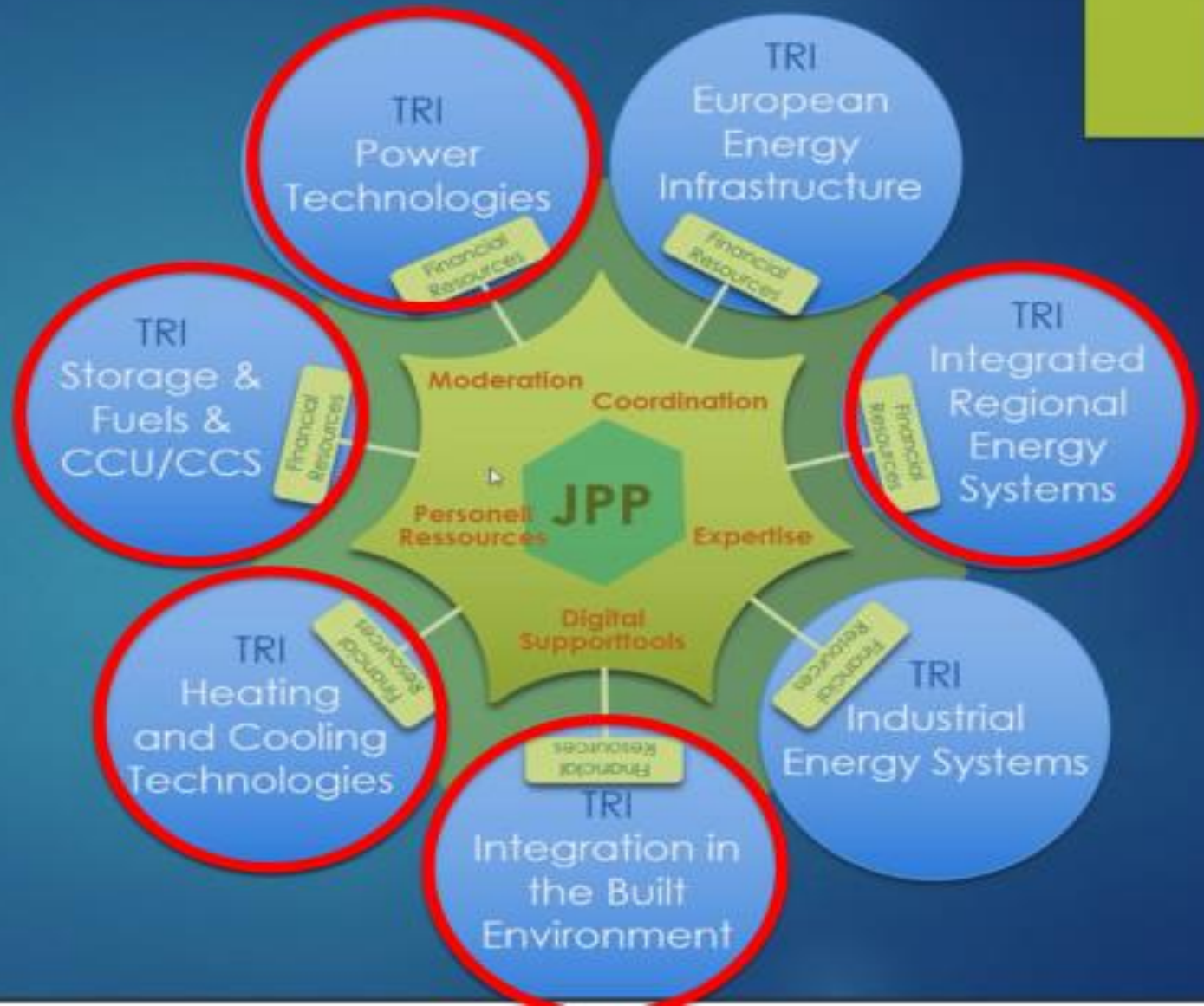
1. Three independent legal entities from at least three different countries, out of which at least two must be EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries
2. Project proposals prepared in English and submitted via the CETPartnership Application System before the deadline.
3. Designated proposal forms must be used.
4. Efforts of one partner cannot exceed 60%, one country/region cannot exceed 75% of the total project efforts (=budget).

Call 2022

- In total 110 pre-proposals, involving 760 partners
- Budget €143 003 948
- Estonian partners in 5 pre-proposals
- Full proposal stage - 3 projects
- Final evaluation until mid-June
- Funding list compiled in August
- Start of the projects before the end of 2023

Call 2023

- Call text will be finalised in May 2023
- June 7th 2023 - call pre-announcement event
- Final budget, national rules, EC approval – August
- Call announcement in September 2023
